## ANTI- SHARK FINNING POLICY

Conservation Measure 3.1 of the International Seafood Sustainability Foundation (ISSF) defines shark finning as “the practice of retaining shark fins and discarding the remaining carcass while at sea”.

Actemsa S.A. is aware that shark finning contravenes the FAO Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries and its International Plan of Action for the Conservation and Management of Sharks, as well as the resolutions of a number of other international marine bodies, all of which call for minimizing waste and discards.

For these reasons, taking into account the management measures applied by Regional Organizations (RFMOs) and national and international standards for the conservation of marine life, Actemsa S.A. has established into its Policy the following points:

1. To condemn and forbid shark finning
2. To avoid any commercial transaction with vessels which have been identified by the Regional Organizations (**RFMOs**) or by national/international authorities as practitioners of shark finning.
3. To avoid commercial dealings with any company that does not have a public policy that prohibits and condemns the practice of shark finning
